Critical Access Behavioral Health Agency (CABHA) is an entity which provides a continuum of care for the age and disability to be served; specific to Youth Villages, the primarily population age is youth through the age of 21 in the mental health arena. The primary specific services provided in Youth Villages CABHA continuum includes: Multisystemic Therapy (MST); Intensive In-Home (IIH) Services; Comprehensive Clinical Assessment (CCA); Medication Management, and Outpatient Therapy. Additional services may be added.

Position Overview

The CCA Assessor will provide comprehensive clinical assessments for consumers entering into OR transitioning within the service continuum of Youth Villages and work directly with the clinical home provider in the development of the PCP for services, natural supports, and crisis prevention activities.

Therapists will provide access to 24 hour coverage for emergency services.

Requirements

A Masters degree in a social services discipline is required (excluding education, criminal justice, theology and divinity majors).

Applicants must be licensed in North Carolina with one of the following licenses: LCSW, LPC, LMFT, LPA, or licensed psychologist (doctorate level).

Must be eligible to bill for procedures, products, and services related to comprehensive clinical assessments and outpatient behavioral health services.

Must meet Medicaid's qualifications for participation.

Must be currently enrolled with N.C. Medicaid.
