Freedom House Recovery Center is seeking a full-time fully **Licensed Clinician** (LPC, LCAS or LCSW) for our Chapel Hill Outpatient Clinic. The successful candidate must have a Master's degree in a Human Services field; be fully licensed in the State of North Carolina, and have two years of direct clinical experience in MH/SA populations. If dually licensed, only one license can be provisional. Experience with Medicaid and State requirements is preferred.

As a licensed clinician, the successful candidate should be enrolled with the Council for Affordable Quality Healthcare (CAQH), NCTRACKS and the appropriate MCO (i.e. Cardinal Innovations or Sandhills) before starting to work at FHRC. Additionally, the successful candidate must: be able to provide both group and individual therapy and assessments to adults and adolescents; have effective time management skills; be able to handle clinical crises and to make quick decisions regarding clinical dispositions; be able to provide crisis intervention when necessary; have knowledge of community resources and advocacy services; have knowledge of the socio-cultural characteristics of the population being served; have the ability to understand and apply relevant laws, regulations, rules, standards, policies and procedures; and, possess good interpersonal, oral and written communication and computer skills.
