### **Summary**

Youth Employment Navigators are responsible for working with juvenile justice involved 16-17 year olds on implementation of individual career development plans to promote a path towards job readiness.

## Specific position duties and responsibilities:

- Networks, develops and maintains new relationships with local area businesses/employers and educational resources that will offer apprenticeship, internship and/or employment opportunities to youth in the program
- Coordinates employment-related opportunities for youth, to include, but not limited to, providing job search assistance and interview support
- Works with the Career Success Coach in supporting youth in implementing their Individualized Career
   Development Plans, evaluating progress towards goals and problem solving around barriers
- Supports the Career Success Coach in the delivery of career focused mentoring sessions that supports the development of soft skills relevant to attainment of employment
- Provides support in conducting program intakes and discharges
- Develops and maintains effective working relationships with stakeholders from the systems that impact program youth
- Complies with all record management requirements
- Keeps accurate documentation of all program interventions
- Enters/tracks program data and provides support to the Director in data management efforts

- Demonstrates a willingness to assist in other agency programs as needed
- Acts as a custodian and demonstrates responsible and ethical use of agency property and facilities
